On Sunday 4/5/2025 Claudia Cream and Joy Biddle were invited to attend the special community commemoration of the 50 years since the fall of Saigon and 50 years of the establishment of the Vietnamese Community Association in Australia. The service was organised by the Vietnamese Veterans of SA inc. and the Vietnamese Community in Australia SA Chapter.

The Berri Commenoration Service of the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Vietnam War was attended by over 120 Veterans, families and visitors. Many Vietnamese and American service men and families had travelled from Adelaide and Melbourne for this unique event that brought together Vietnam Veterans from all allied defence force service branches from Australia, USA and South Vietnam. Veterans from previous and past conflicts including Korea, Middle East, Afghanistan the Gulf war and Peace keeping operations in East Timor were also represented.
